Here is a poem I found tucked in my mothers bible:

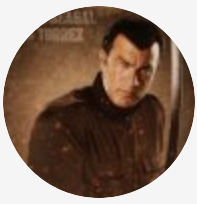
IF GOD SHOULD GO ON STRIKE

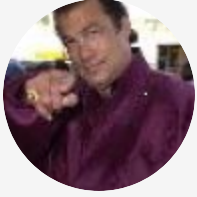
